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Information sheet – COVID-19

You can join us virtually or in person. If you choose to join virtually, please read the guidelines below.

We will be using Microsoft Teams for our meetings.

An invite to the meeting will be sent via email a few days before the meeting, click on 'Join Microsoft Teams Meeting' towards the bottom of the email. You can then download the app or Join on the web.

Some guidelines for using video call:

- Appropriate clothing – dress as if you are meeting in person.
- Consent – we will still need your consent form sent back for you to be able to attend the virtual events.
- Name – when logging in please use just your first name, this will protect your identity.
- Screen – you do not need to have your video on if you would prefer not to be seen, you can use audio and also the chat section to communicate.
- Background – remember if you have your camera on we will be able to see what is behind you. You can blur your background, or use a different background on Teams. When you are logging onto the call it's the button next to the microphone button.
- Space – remember there may be confidential information being shared. Also having a lot of background noise, or people walking past may be distracting. Try to find somewhere to sit where you will be able to feel comfortable, won't be distracted and will be able to fully participate.
- Leaving – if you feel uncomfortable at any point during the meeting please feel free to turn off your audio and/or video or leave the meeting. Please do let Rachel know you are OK on 07827 255922, and she will follow-up with you after the session has ended.

Getting here

The forum will be held in the Children's Outpatients department of Ipswich Hospital.

Car parking

If you or your parent or guardian will be driving to the hospital please let us know the registration plate number, make and model of the car and we can arrange to have it 'white listed' so you will not pay parking charges for Youth Forum events.

Public transport

There are bus stops inside the hospital grounds, just outside the Garrett Anderson Centre (Emergency Department) and on Woodbridge Road, near a pedestrian entrance to hospital grounds.

Routes 2, 5, 5E, 6, 75, 78 and 79 stop inside the hospital grounds. For bus timetables for these routes please visit the Ipswich Buses website.

Routes 63, 64, 65, 66, 66a, 75, 77, 800, 900 and 978 run through the Park and Ride bus stop on the Woodbridge Road entrance to the hospital. For bus timetables for these routes please visit the First website.
