Executive summary	
The report provides an update from the most recent Membership and Engagement Working Group, which took place on 21 February 2024. Membership Engagement Plan Update	
The Working Group received an update on the Membership Engagement Plan, with the progress and revised dates. The group discussed a variety of elements in the plan, including the upcoming Ask 3 Questions project, and improving ways for Governors to provide feedback on engagement, alongside potential subjects for future health talks. The Trust Secretary was keen that these are agreed and scheduled to ensure that action can be demonstrated in delivering the plan. Attendees also heard about the potential re-introduction of a member's welcome letter when members of the public join the Foundation Trust.
