Executive summary	
NHS England published the annual staff survey results for 2023 online on 7 March 2024. Information from the staff survey, including detail of local results, national results and interactive results can be found at NHS Staff Survey (nhsstaffsurveys.com)	
For the staff survey 2023, ESNEFT had a response rate of 51.8%, which is an increase from the 38.8% received at the 2022 staff survey.	
Key highlights from the survey include:	
 The vast majority of our scores this year are significantly better than our results in previous years The scores for 'we are compassionate and inclusive, 'we are recognised and rewarded' and 'we work flexibly' are significantly better than similar organisations to ESNEFT. Scores for staff engagement and staff morale are higher than those achieved in 2022 One question score has shown decline. This relates to staff experiencing discrimination at work from patients, service users, their relatives, or other members of the public.
